


<u>MAJOR VIOLENT CRIME</u> JANUARY - JUNE (Incidents Per 100,000 Population and Numbers)¹

<u>MAJOR PROPERTY CRIME</u> JANUARY - JUNE (Incidents Per 100,000 Population and Numbers)¹








NUMBER OF REPORTED OFFENSES INVOLVING GUNS IN MEMPHIS¹ JANUARY - JUNE










SHELBY COUNTY'S RETURN RATE FOR FELONY INMATES RELEASED FROM INCARCERATION*



<u>DOMESTIC VIOLENCE</u> JANUARY - JUNE (Incidents Per 100,000 Population and Numbers)¹




